What's That Big Machine

Outside the Education Building?

You may have noticed a strange machine with big hoses outside the Educational Building and we wanted to give you an update. Last week we started experiencing issues with the chiller that provides cooling water to the Educational Building. This chiller was only 3 years old, and was not replaced when we did the HVAC repairs to that building. We discovered on Monday that the heat exchanger in the unit had developed a crack and would have to be replaced. Unfortunately, that major part is custom made for our unit, and it will take a month to get the new part. Temperatures quickly skyrocketed in the building forcing us to close the Child Development Center on Tuesday and consider our options. Our Trustees quickly determined that the only option that would keep us from closing down the CDC for a month was to rent a temporary chiller to provide cold water during the period when our permanent chiller is down. We had a 30 ton chiller delivered and installed on Tuesday, ensuring that when the CDC opened for business Thursday morning we had adequate cooling in the building. Thanks to our Trustees and Ronald Davidson for all they did to make sure that we could continue God's work here at City Road Chapel.
