## Heading to the Mountain

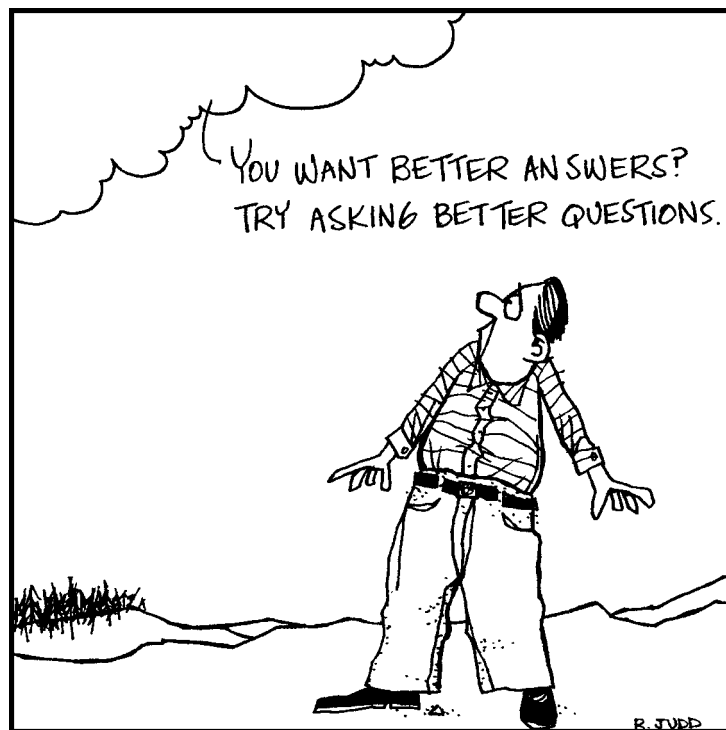
