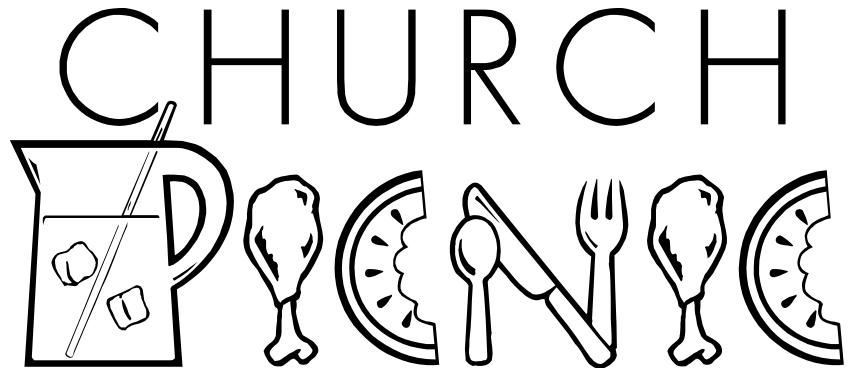

## CCM is Busy Sharing Blessings

During the first 8 months of 2018, Christian Cooperative Ministry (CCM) distributed **3,408 food boxes** that provided meals for 3 days for **9,300 people**. In addition, as of the end of August, CCM had given 2,556 sack lunches to homeless individuals and distributed 17,433 pieces of clothing. Your donations, financial contributions, and prayers enable this ministry to serve hungry people in our community. Thank you. Be assured that thousands of people are blessed *because of you*.
