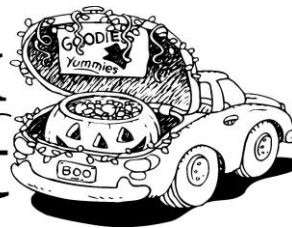
**Feed the Need Food Bag Prep**
