Thank You! From 13,520 People

During 2018, Christian Cooperative Ministry (CCM) distributed **5,206 emergency food boxes that provided meals for 3 days to 13,520 people.** CCM continues to be one of the busiest Second Harvest partner agencies in Davidson County.

There is more news to share. CCM also gave 3,744 lunch sacks to hungry homeless individuals and distributed 23,573 items of clothing to the people it served. In addition, 236 special Thanksgiving food boxes were given to families and approximately 200 children received Christmas toys and treats.

The work of CCM is possible because of your generous donations -- and the support and contributions of other Madison churches, businesses, organizations and individuals. Because of these combined efforts -- hungry, needy people in our community are fed and clothed as they are respectfully and lovingly served.
