It's Prayer Time for the United Methodist Church

Next weekend, representatives from all across the world will be gathering in St. Louis, MO for a special called General Conference to consider the work of the *Way Forward Commission* and making decisions about the future of the United Methodist Church. This work and gathering arises from the ongoing debate over the past 50 years regarding human sexuality, what it means to be a connectional church, and if there is a way of remaining one church in the face of the divisions and disagreements in our church.

The General Conference will begin on Saturday, Feb. 23 with a special time of prayer in which all of the delegates will be gathering to pray for God's Spirit to be with them and asking the Holy Spirit to speak. They are also asking United Methodist throughout the world to join them in a special time of prayer for our church on that day.
