CCM Requests Personal Care Items

Soap, Toothpaste, Toilet paper, and Shampoo. None of these items that we use every day can be purchased with SNAP (food stamp) benefits. As many families in our community struggle to put food on the table, they often have to do without these personal care items.

While Christian Cooperative Ministry's (CCM) core mission is to provide food and clothing to those in need, whenever possible CCM likes to provide its clients with some of the "extras" -- like soap and shampoo -- that help people maintain their health and dignity. Your donations of these items would be greatly appreciated. They can be placed in the donation box in front of the reception desk in the church office.

Update on CCM activity: During the first two months of 2019, CCM distributed 807 food boxes that provided meals for 3 days to 2,224 people. In addition, 557 sack lunches were given to homeless individuals and 2,837 items of clothing were distributed. All of this is possible because of *your support* and donations from other churches, individuals, organizations and businesses. **Thank you. Bless you.**
