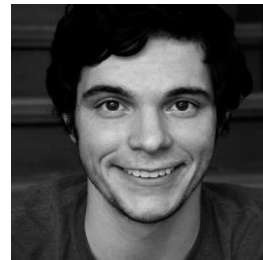
Narcotics Anonymous meets Mon.-Sat. at noon and Sunday at 1 p.m.
