Welcome Launchpad

Last year we were pleased to partner with Launchpad Nashville, an organization that is providing winter sheltering for homeless persons between the ages of 18 and 24. Younger folks living on the streets are often unwilling to go to the Rescue Mission or Room in the Inn because of safety issues. Launchpad offers a place where folks can be housed with others their own age and offers services for these folks to try and help them find a path towards having a home.

We will be serving as a host facility for Launchpad again this year starting in November and will be needing volunteers to help with this program. The primary needs are doing laundry and providing a meal for 20-25 people.

We are also happy to announce that Launchpad will be renting space in the Neely's Bend building for their offices. We want to welcome their new executive director, Ty Brown, to this place and he will be available to answer and questions you have about the program.

New Discussion Series starts this Wednesday

This Wednesday we will be starting a new discussion series as a part of our regular Vespers gathering. This particular series will focus on Christian practices – those actions and rituals we do which help us better connect to God. For the next 8 weeks we will be using a video that leads us into a conversation around prayer, table fellowship, worship, the sacraments, generosity, service, and community. The Vespers experience also includes singing, Holy Communion, and intercessory prayer. ALL are encouraged to come join in this special time every Wednesday at 6 p.m.

The new rubber surface is scheduled to be poured the week of September 23 and we hope that we can dedicate the new playground around the first of October.
