Throughout the month of October we will be thinking about the importance of relationship to our Christian faith. John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, wrote that

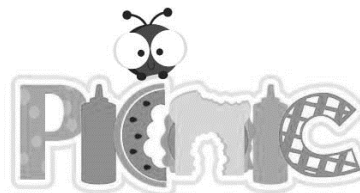
