Lent 2020 – Drawing Deeper to God

The season of Lent is almost here and we hope that you are getting ready for this important season in the life of our church.

Lent is the 40 days before Easter (not including Sundays) in which people of faith spend extra time in fasting, prayer, and meditation on our relationship with God.


Traditionally, many have “given up” some activity or practice for Lent, although in more recent years others have advocated for “putting on” some new practice of faith. The goal is to be emotionally and spiritually prepared for the journey to the cross and the celebration of the resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Lent begins on Wednesday, February 26 as we take ashes upon ourselves as a sign of our penitence. For the next 40 days all are encouraged to focus in an intentional way on our relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

Throughout the season of Lent we will be spending time in Paul’s letter to the Romans on Sunday mornings, thinking about our sin and Christ’s justification of us all.

We also will be providing Lenten devotional guides from our friends at the Society of St. Andrew to guide us in our prayer and reflection.
