CCM Gives Thanks for You!

Because of generous donations and contributions from YOU and its other supporters, in October, Christian Cooperative Ministry (CCM) was able to distribute 543 food boxes that fed 1,471 people for at least three days. There is more good news! CCM also provided 1,848 items of donated clothing to people in need and gave out 600 sack lunches to people without a home.

Now CCM is at work distributing more than 200 special Thanksgiving food boxes to the families it serves. These special boxes are given out in addition to the regular food boxes that families receive. Once again, this project is possible because of donations from you and other churches, businesses, organizations, and individuals in our community. Thank you for being a part of this effort to bring blessings to the Thanksgiving tables of so many people.

Looking ahead: On December 16, CCM will give away toys to 200 Madison children. This annual event is hosted here at City Road Chapel. Donations of toys and stocking stuffers are appreciated.
