On the first Friday of each month, Nashville Street Barbers are on site to provide haircuts to folks living on



the streets. It is amazing the change in how we perceive others when they are clean and when their hair is in order. Nashville Street Barbers was founded by Caroline Lindner, a former

navigator in our Housing Navigation Center, who has been present with us for worship from time to time.
