

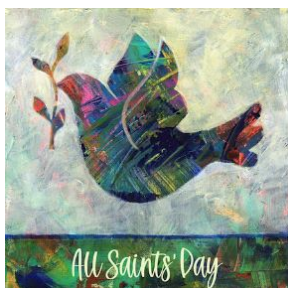
Life on the Road
