Forgiveness

As we continue our journey of faith, we are reminded of the importance of forgiveness and reconciliation.

Forgiveness is not always easy, especially when someone has hurt us deeply. Yet, holding onto anger and resentment can weigh heavily on our hearts. God calls us to extend grace to others just as He extends grace to us.

Take a moment this week to think about someone you may need to forgive. It may be someone who hurt you years ago, someone who disappointed you, or perhaps someone with whom you simply need to make peace. Forgiveness doesn't mean forgetting what happened or pretending that the hurt wasn't real. Instead, it means choosing to release that hurt into God's hands and allowing Him to bring healing to your heart.

Sometimes forgiveness is a process that takes time and prayer. Ask God to give you the strength, compassion, and peace you need to take that next step. When we let go of resentment and make room for God's love, we may discover that forgiveness brings healing not only to our relationships, but also to our own hearts.
