The Golden Rule Every Day

We've all heard the phrase, **"Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."** (Luke 6:31) But why do we call it the **Golden**

Rule? Gold has long been considered precious and valuable, and this simple rule is a valuable guide for how we treat the people around us. It reminds us to treat others with the same kindness, patience, respect, and consideration that we would want to receive.

Following the Golden Rule doesn't require grand gestures. It's often found in the small, everyday choices we make and the way we interact with the people around us. Here are a few simple ways we can put the Golden Rule into practice each day:

- ★ Let someone go ahead of you in line when they're in a hurry.
- ★ Hold the door open for someone behind you.
- ★ Say please, thank you, and you're welcome.
- ★ Be patient when someone makes a mistake.
- ★ Pick up something someone dropped.
- ★ Let someone finish speaking instead of interrupting.
- ★ Check on a friend or neighbor who may be having a difficult day.
- ★ Clean up after yourself, especially in shared spaces.
- ★ Put your phone away and give someone your full attention.
- ★ Give someone a genuine compliment or word of encouragement.
- ★ Be mindful of your noise when others are resting or working.
- ★ Offer to help someone who looks like they could use an extra hand.
- ★ Smile and greet people instead of walking past them.
- ★ Give people the benefit of the doubt instead of assuming the worst.
